



WESTERN MARYLAND SIGNATURE DRINKS

THE 1309 OLD FASHIONED

Named after the largest regular-operating steam locomotive in the world: Our very own Baldwin-built 1309. This old-fashioned includes Bourbon on the rocks, with a hint of sugar and bitters, garnished with orange and cherry accents.

THE 558 OLD FASHIONED

Named after the Western Maryland 558, a b32-8 locomotive built in 1980 and currently the most powerful diesel on the railroad's roster. This Old Fashioned introduces honey for a sweeter bourbon on the rocks, with a dash of bitters, and topped with garnish.

THE 734 OLD FASHIONED

The 734 was derived from Western Maryland's Steam Locomotive fan favorite of over 24 years, which is currently awaiting restoration in our railyard. Using maple syrup, this Old Fashioned adds on a local twist made up of bourbon on the rocks, a dash of bitters, and garnish.

THE CUMBERLAND MANHATTAN

The Queen City of Cumberland was the second biggest city in Maryland at one time, and the center point of the state's transportation network. This classic Manhattan is perfect to feel like a rail baron of the day. Comprised of Bourbon, sweet vermouth, a dash of bitters, and a cherry.

THE FROSTBURG MANHATTAN

Frostburg was a rough and tough coal mining town of the Alleghenies, there were the miners but also the mine owners. Take a Coal Tycoons take on a Manhattan with Bourbon, Coffee Liqueur, a dash of bitters, and an orange peel garnish.

THE C&P SOUR

The Cumberland & Pennsylvania ran coal out of these hills since the time of the Civil War. Switch backing up and down the mountainsides, it was one of the steepest railroads around. Enjoy this classic Whiskey Sour garnished with a lemon and cherry.

≡ **THE MOUNT SAVAGE LEMONADE** ≡

In the valley below the railroad lies Mount Savage, the town that fueled the industrial revolution with the region's discovery of iron mining, coal mining, and fire clay. The first iron rail in the country was made in the Mount Savage Iron Works, and in a town like that, lemonade was never enough. Cool off with this cocktail of Whiskey, Triple Sec, sour mix, and lime soda, with a lemon garnish.

≡ **THE COAL POCKET** ≡

These hills are filled with coal, and you just may see some veins in the rocks and cuts as you travel along. Enjoy this refreshing drink of Vodka paired with Raspberry Chambord on the rocks and a splash of lemon-lime fizz, topped with garnish.

≡ **THE B&O** ≡



The First railroad in the country was the Baltimore & Ohio. Reaching Cumberland in 1850, freight trains still use this route today to cross the Alleghenies. Enjoy this drink of Vodka, butterscotch schnapps, Kahlua, and Baileys Irish Cream.

≡ **THE C&O** ≡



Steam locomotive 1309 was built for the Chesapeake & Ohio Railroad in 1949. Hauling coal out of the mountains, she was strong and powerful, but retired after seven years of service when the railroad dieselized. Listen to her steam with this cocktail of Vodka, rum, a splash of triple sec, orange juice and pineapple juice.

≡ **THE WESTERN MARYLAND** ≡ **WM** ≡

With our route completed in 1912, the Western Maryland evolved from a local regional coal hauler into a fast freight route used to compete with B&O over the rigorous mountains. This cocktail comprises Gin, a splash of orange juice, and seltzer water to get you right where you're going.

≡ **THE FAST FREIGHT** ≡

The Western Maryland was the "Fast Freight Line", hauling coal, lumber, and other products out of the mountains down to the port of Baltimore. Enjoy this classic Bloody Mary with Vodka, tomato juice, a dash of old bay, and other spices. Ask for its FIREBALL style if you want it extra spicy.

≡ **THE COAL MINER COFFEE** ≡

Many coal workers were immigrants coming from all over the world to work in these hills. Have a coffee like a coal miner with Coffee, Baileys Irish Cream, and a little jack added for that extra bite.

≡ **THE CHESSIE SLEEPER** ≡

Sleep Like a Kitten was the C&O slogan of the famous Chessie Cat, promoting the most comfortable sleeping cars on the rails. Sit back and relax with this Hot Chocolate, Bailey's Irish Cream, and whip cream.

≡ **THE GEORGES CREEK** ≡

The Georges Creek Valley on the other side of Frostburg was home to many coal mines. The C&P Railroad tunneled under Frostburg to reach the valley. The tunnel can still be seen behind our turntable in Frostburg. Stay warm with Hot Chocolate, Kahlua, and whip cream.
